



What is a Political Action Committee (PAC)?

- ⚙️ PACs are legal entities created to solicit contributions and use the funds raised to support candidates for political office.
- ⚙️ There are many types of PACs, but NAEDA PAC is a Separate Segregated Fund (SSF), which can only solicit contributions from individuals associated with a connected or sponsoring organization.

NAEDA PAC is a Dealer-driven, Consensus Organization

- ⚙️ The NAEDA Board of Directors established the PAC and provided for its governance.
 - ⚙️ PAC bylaws establish a committee as the entity's decision-making body.
 - ⚙️ The PAC Committee comprises the NAEDA VP of Government Affairs, Director of Government Affairs, and three to five dealer members in good standing.
 - ⚙️ The PAC Committee oversees fundraising and distribution of funds.

Pursuing Positive Public Policy Outcomes for Successful Dealers

- ⚙️ NAEDA PAC strengthens the North American Equipment Dealers Association's Advocacy efforts.
 - ⚙️ Provides NAEDA and its members an opportunity to contribute to candidates for office who support equipment dealers and their policy goals.
 - ⚙️ PAC funds help dealers engage and build relationships with their elected officials.
 - ⚙️ Connect dealers with elected officials who matter most to the issues affecting the industry today and in the future.
 - ⚙️ Raises the profile of the association and the equipment dealer industry.

Committed to Comply with Legal and Ethical Standards

- ⚙️ NAEDA PAC, as an SSF of the North American Equipment Dealers Associations, can only solicit contributions from individuals who work for or represent organizations that are association members.
- ⚙️ NAEDA PAC must have Prior Approval from member organizations before making solicitations for contributions.
