

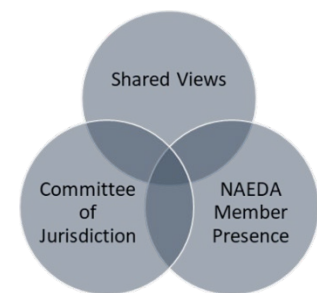


What is a Political Action Committee (PAC)?

- ⚙️ PACs are legal entities created to solicit contributions and use the funds raised to support candidates for political office.
- ⚙️ NAEDA PAC is an important tool for dealers because it supports candidates for Congress who share their values and have the most influence in policy-making.

How does NAEDA PAC work?

- ⚙️ Federal law requires a two-step process for NAEDA members to participate with the PAC.
 - ⚙️ 1) NAEDA members must give the PAC “prior authorization” through a signed form before the PAC’s staff can discuss any benefits members may derive from the PAC or ask for contributions.
 - ⚙️ 2) Once NAEDA members have given prior authorization, the PAC’s staff may discuss all aspects of the PAC and include them in regular solicitation events and communications.
 - ⚙️ The principle behind this process is to prevent large organizations from using coercive practices while raising funds for political purposes.
 - ⚙️ All participation with the PAC is voluntary, and providing prior authorization does not commit a member to contributing.
- ⚙️ NAEDA PAC uses funds raised to support candidates for Congress based primarily on three criteria as outlined in the PAC’s by-laws:
 - ⚙️ The candidate must be a member of a committee with jurisdiction over an issue relevant to NAEDA members.
 - ⚙️ The candidate must have NAEDA members in their district.
 - ⚙️ The candidate must have shared values with NAEDA members.



NAEDA PAC is a Dealer-driven, Consensus Organization:

- ⚙️ The NAEDA Board of Directors established the PAC and provided for its governance.
- ⚙️ PAC by-laws establish a committee of dealers as the entity's decision-making body.

It Doesn't Take Much:

- ⚙️ Federal law sets the maximum amount individuals can contribute to a PAC.
- ⚙️ \$5,000 per calendar year.
